Come as a team, on your own or as a group of friends. The day is open to both men and women of any stature. At the Dancing England Rapper Tournament (DERT 2018) more than half the prizes were won by female or mixed teams. If you are coming as a team, a group discount may be available. Please enquire before booking.

What is this sword dancing then?

Rapper sword is a fun and fast-paced style of dance for five, with interconnected dancers using a 'rapper' or short sword made of flexible sprung steel with a handle at each end. Its origins lie in North East England and is mostly danced to jigs in 6/8 time.

Longsword uses longer stiff swords with a single fixed handle. Dancers work as a team of usually six/eight connected dancers, weaving over and under the swords. Green Man have a new sword dance to bring to the workshop this year.

Wear comfortable clothing that allows you to move freely. Trainers or similar are suitable for longsword but please bring hard-soled shoes without metal taps for the rapper session if you have them.
